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MINUTES

RAC Advisory Committee August 16, 2023

1. **CALL TO ORDER** – Rico E. Medina called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m.
2. **ROLL CALL** – Present: Kris Gonzales, Kelly Lethin (late), Rico E. Medina, Malissa Netane-Jones, Michael Palmer, Jim Ruane, and Michael Salazar (late). Absence: Auros Harman.
3. **PUBLIC COMMENTS FOR ITEMS NOT ON THE AGENDA** – None.
4. **ACCEPTANCE OF MINUTES** – The Committee accepted the minutes of the June 21, 2023 meeting as submitted.

5. **NEW BUSINESS**

- a. Construction Update and Look Ahead
Project Manager Rod Macaraeg presented an update to the Committee.

Rico E. Medina asked if schools would be notified about City Park Road closures. He asked about the August 18th or August 21st dates for PG&E.

Jim Ruane asked about a new sidewalk on Crystal Springs all the way from Donner to the Oak intersection. He stated that the weeds on Crystal Springs were unsightly. He asked if there were plans to take more eucalyptus out.

Kelly Lethin asked about the Beckner Road redesign and the path that goes from Senior Center to the Recreation Center.

Michael Salazar asked if payments were up to date. He asked about the advanced technology equipment and design and whether they were incorporated into the initial design and accounted for. He asked about the potential to reuse some of the equipment that was purchased for the Senior Center.

Kelly Lethin asked about the current creek work and the landscaping timeline.

Kris Gonzales asked about the stop light timeline.

Mike Palmer asked what CMU meant.

Jim Ruane asked about a site tour.

Michael Salazar asked about the traffic light and the compatibility with emergency service vehicles, the timing of the signals, and the possibility of the addition of cameras and license plate readers.

Jim Ruane asked if there would be flashing lights for pedestrians.

Kelly Lethin asked about the programming of signals for pedestrians. She asked if there would be signage about the slower road through the park and raised crosswalks.

Project Manager Rod Macaraeg answered the questions.

Committee discussed no meeting in September and a later meeting in October. It would be decided later if meetings after October would be necessary.
