April 1 will be the City's Easter Egg Hunt as well as the Lion's Club pancake breakfast and the PD will be in attendance. A Police Day at Tanforan is being considered on May 20. The Torch Run which benefits the Special Olympics will be held on June 23.

8. **COMMENTS FROM MEMBERS:**

a. Radio Club: The March meeting was held in the EOC and radio room to discuss the Mesh system and demonstrate various types of equipment and antennas. Dave said there are 124 hams in San Bruno but few are actually active. The recent grant from the Community Foundation will be used to update the Club's equipment.

b. CERT: The new CERT classes started on March 8 and are being held in the EOC. Firefighter Rehab classes will be held at a date TBD and CERT graduates will be encouraged to take them.

c. Red Cross: The Red Cross is providing training for kids, discussing the 'pillow case' project and how to prepare for home fires and earthquakes. CPR classes are being given by RC nurses. On April 8, the RC will be installing free smoke alarms in San Bruno. The RC now has a new software program which can keep track of those injured.
