NOTICE OF TREE REMOVAL

Consistent with Section 8.25.020 of the City's Municipal Code, that a Tree Removal Permit has been approved for the removal of a Heritage Tree located at **324 Florida Avenue**.

A Heritage Tree is defined as:

- a. Any native bay, buckeye, oak, redwood, or pine tree that has a diameter of six inches or more measured at fifty four inches above natural grade;
- b. Any tree or stand of trees designed by resolution of the City Council to be of special historical value or of significant community benefit;
- c. A stand of trees, the nature of which makes each dependent on the others for survival; or
- d. Any other tree with a trunk diameter of ten inches or more, measured at fifty four inches above natural grade.

Consistent with the conditions of the tree removal permit, replanting new trees in the same or alternate location is required.

You may file a written appeal to this decision no later than 5:00 p.m. on Sunday, September 30, 2018. This appeal should be addressed to the Community Services Director, 567 El Camino Real, San Bruno, CA. If you have questions, please contact 650-616-7187.
