### **City of San Bruno to Resume Utility Construction in Crestmoor Neighborhood**

**San Bruno, Calif.** – The City of San Bruno notified residents earlier today that work will resume on the construction of utilities within the Crestmoor neighborhood. This work involves repair and replacement of sewer and waterlines that were damaged in the PG&E gas pipeline explosion and fire in September 2010.

The construction work was halted last Thursday after the City's contractor, Shaw Pipeline clipped a two-inch PG&E gas line near Earl Avenue and Glenview Drive, while digging with a backhoe, in nearly the same location as the deadly 2010 incident. Immediately after last Thursday's incident, Shaw apologized for the accident, accepted full responsibility, and agreed to provide additional safety procedures and protocols for the remainder of the project.

The City has reviewed the new safety measures and will allow Shaw to resume the construction beginning early next week pending their implementation. Daily on-site safety meetings will be held to help avoid a similar future incident. Close City oversight will be provided for the duration of the project. The work is expected to be completed by the end of September.
