The City of San Bruno in collaboration with a committee of Crestmoor neighborhood residents (affected by the Glenview fire) have planned and organized a September 9 One-Year Remembrance and September 11 Neighborhood Gathering in recognition of the September 9, 2010 pipeline explosion and fire in San Bruno.

The September 9 One-Year Remembrance will be held on Friday, September 9, 2011 in the Quad area at Skyline College, 3300 College Drive in San Bruno. Ceremonies will promptly begin at 6:00 p.m., although those attending are encouraged to arrive by 5:30 p.m. On Sunday, September 11, 2011, the City will host the Crestmoor Neighborhood (Glenview Area) One-Year Gathering at City Park at 251 City Park Way in San Bruno. Sunday's gathering will celebrate rebuilding and restoring and the community spirit of the Crestmoor neighborhood.

The Committee has intentionally identified these events with the Crestmoor neighborhood since the impacts were felt beyond Glenview Avenue. This change marks the neighborhood's desire to focus on moving forward toward rebuilding and restoring their neighborhood.
