**SAN BRUNO, CA – September 13, 2010** – The City of San Bruno is providing this update regarding the Glenview Fire:

- Police Chief Neil Telford said that San Bruno Police Department officers will continue to patrol the Glenview Fire area throughout the week. Telford said that “our goal is security and we will continue to ensure the public’s safety.”
- San Bruno Public Works reports that streetlights and sewer service in the area have been restored. Work on phone and cable TV service is continuing.
- At 1am Monday morning, Sneath Lane was opened to vehicle traffic for the first time since the fire.
- Congresswoman Jackie Speier will be hosting a Federal/State briefing tonight at 8pm for San Bruno residents. Representatives from National Transportation and Safety Board (NTSB), Pipeline Hazardous Material Safety Administration (PHMSA) and California Public Utilities Commission (PUC) will discuss the ongoing investigation and pipeline status, at the Church of the Highlands, 1900 Monterey Dr., San Bruno.
