Glenview Fire - Update

SAN BRUNO, CA – September 16, 2010 – The City of San Bruno is providing this update regarding the Glenview Fire:

- The Local Assistance Center, which was located at the Recreation Center has transitioned to the San Bruno Recovery Center located at 900 Cherry Street, 3rd Floor. Service agencies including the Red Cross & PG&E are at the center to assist victims of the disaster. The hours of the center are from 9 a.m.- 6 p.m., seven days a week.
- County Environmental Health is coordinating debris removal operations through their office at the San Bruno Recovery Center.
- Number of damaged residences are as follows:
 - 37 homes Destroyed
 - 16 homes with Major Damage
 - 32 homes with Minor Damage
- To ensure a safe clearing of the neighborhood, representatives from the City, County, and State will meet with residents of destroyed or red-tagged homes to explain the process for removing debris from their properties. The meeting will take place Friday, September 17th at 2pm at the Veterans Memorial Center. This is **not** a public meeting; the meeting will be immediately followed by a press conference.
- Tomorrow, September 17th, 2010 at 8:30a.m. Pacific Gas & Electric will be power-washing power lines in the area of disaster site to remove debris from the lines. For more information please call (800) 743-5000.
