RESOLUTION NO. 2013 - 104

**ADOPT A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN BRUNO, CALIFORNIA,
RECITING THE FACTS OF THE GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION HELD ON NOVEMBER 5, 2013,
DECLARING THE RESULTS AND SUCH OTHER MATTERS AS PROVIDED BY LAW**

WHEREAS, a General Municipal Election was held and conducted in the City of San Bruno, California, on Tuesday, November 5, 2013, as required by law; and

WHEREAS, notice of the election was given in time, form and manner as provided by law; that voting precincts were properly established; that election officers were appointed and that in all respects the election was held and conducted and the votes were cast, received and canvassed and the returns made and declared in time, form and manner as required by the provisions of the Elections Code of the State of California for the holding of elections in general law cities; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 2013 – 60 adopted July 11, 2013, the County Election Department canvassed the returns of the election and has certified the results to this City Council, the results are received, attached and made a part hereof as "Exhibit A".

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN BRUNO CALIFORNIA,
DOES RESOLVE, DECLARE, DETERMINE AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:**

SECTION 1. That the whole number of votes cast in the precincts including absent voter ballots and provisional ballots was 4,450.

SECTION 2. That the name of the person voted for at the election for Mayor is: Jim Ruane.

That the names of persons voted for at the election for Member of the City Council are as follows: Ken Ibarra and Rico E. Medina.

That the name of the person voted for at the election for City Treasurer is: John Marty.

That the name of the person voted for at the election for City Clerk is: Carol Bonner.

SECTION 3. That the number of votes given at each precinct and the number of votes given in the City to each of the persons above named for the respective offices for which the persons were candidates listed in Exhibit "A" attached.

SECTION 4. The City Council does declare and determine that Jim Ruane was elected as Mayor for the full term of two years; Ken Ibarra was elected as Member of the City Council for the full term of four years; Rico E. Medina was elected as Member of the City Council for the full term of four years; John Marty was elected as Treasurer for the full term of four years; and, Carol Bonner was elected as City Clerk for the full term of four years.

SECTION 5. The City Clerk shall enter on the records of the City Council of the City, a statement of the result of the election, showing: (1) The whole number of votes cast in the City; (2) The names of the persons voted for; (3) For what office each person was voted for; (4) The number of votes given at each precinct to each person; (6) The total number of votes given to each person.

SECTION 6. That the City Clerk shall immediately make and deliver to each of the persons so elected a Certificate of Election signed by the City Clerk and authenticated; that the City Clerk shall also administer to each person elected the Oath of Office prescribed in the Constitution of the State of California and shall have them subscribe to it and file it in the office of the City Clerk. Each and all of the persons so elected shall then be inducted into the respective office to which they have been elected.

SECTION 7. That the City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this resolution and enter it into the book of original resolutions.
