On Thursday, October 6, 2016, at approximately 6:38 p.m., San Bruno Police Officers responded to a shopping center located on the 800 block of Cherry Avenue regarding a male who had threatened two persons with a knife after they had observed the male slashing the tires of a parked vehicle.

Officers located and detained twenty-seven year old San Bruno resident Vance Demartini, who was identified by witnesses as the person who brandished a knife and made criminal threats.

Demartini was arrested and booked into the San Mateo County Jail for charges related to criminal threats, weapons violations, witness dissuasion, vandalism, and drug related charges.
