On Friday, November 13, 2015, at approximately 1:10 p.m., San Bruno Police Department Personnel conducted surveillance in the area of the Tanforan Mall and Towne Center Shopping Center. Similar to other parts of the county and state, these commercial parking areas are particularly susceptible to auto burglaries.

During this operation, officers observed a suspicious vehicle frequenting parking lots in both shopping areas. The manner in which the vehicle traveled through the parking lots and the behavior of its occupants outside of the vehicle were consistent with those looking to burglarize vehicles.

Officers contacted subjects inside the vehicle, identified as San Francisco residents Rashad Shambray-Jones and Kelvon Watts, who were found to be in possession of instruments used the force entry into vehicles. Both subject were arrested for possessing burglary tools.

Both Shambray-Jones and Watts signed promises to appear for the misdemeanor violations and were released shortly thereafter.

The San Bruno Police Department takes all crime, including property crimes, extremely seriously. The Department assumes a proactive approach to prevent and investigate burglaries, employing a number of different methods. Among these is a vigilant public who promptly reports suspicious persons and/or vehicles in their neighborhoods.
