SUBJECT: Grand Theft / Criminal Conspiracy Arrest

On Thursday, December 31, 2016, at approximately 10:42 p.m. San Bruno Police Officers responded to a business on the 300 block of San Bruno Avenue regarding the report of a physical altercation.

Upon arrival, officers contacted three subjects who advised that they had agreed to meet an acquaintance at the business for the purpose of purchasing two pounds of marijuana. The subjects provided a large sum of money for the marijuana transaction but the suspects failed to provide the marijuana and left the area in a vehicle.

Officers detained the following subjects inside a vehicle nearby:

- Elisa Ann Johnson, a 20 year old resident of Clearlake, California
- Ian Leopald Marshall, a 34 year old resident of Pembroke Pines, Florida
- Herman Eugene Wilson, a 49 year old resident of Clearlake, California

A large sum of money, but no marijuana, was found inside the vehicle. Elisa Johnson, Ian Marshall and Herman Wilson were all identified as the suspects engaged in the attempted marijuana transaction and they were subsequently arrested for grand theft and criminal conspiracy then booked at the San Mateo County Jail.

The San Bruno Police Department discourages the purchasing of marijuana or other drugs. Purchasing drugs, even from acquaintances is a risky endeavor, which often results in tragic consequences for unsuspecting victims.
