On Friday, January 1, 2016, at approximately 8:01 a.m. officers from the San Bruno Police Department responded to a business on the 600 block of Huntington Avenue regarding the report of an armed robbery and assault.

The victim reported that he had met with two subjects and accompanied them to a vehicle. The subjects drove the victim to a location within San Bruno, produced a firearm, and robbed the victim of personal property and cash.

A subsequent investigation resulted in the arrest of twenty-eight year old Daniel Larios, and twenty-five year old Augustine Sandoval Jr., both residents of East Palo Alto. The suspects were booked into the San Mateo County Main Jail for chargers related to kidnapping, robbery, assault with a deadly weapon, criminal conspiracy, and fraudulent use of an access card.
