On Monday, April 4, 2016, at approximately 10:17 a.m., San Bruno Police Officers responded to San Bruno City Park regarding the report of a subject with a knife acting suspiciously. Upon their arrival, officers located Richard Vaneso, a nineteen year old San Bruno resident. As Officers contacted Vaneso they observed a large knife in a sheath on his left side. Vaneso provided officers with false identifying information. A subsequent investigation revealed additional knives concealed upon Vaneso's person. A search of Vaneso's person resulted in the discovery of a San Mateo County Jail issued bracelet with Vaneso's true name. He was also found to be in possession of concentrated cannabis and narcotics paraphernalia.

Upon the discovery of the aforementioned items, Vaneso attempted to flee from officers and was detained following a short foot pursuit. Vaneso was arrested and booked into the San Mateo County Jail pursuant to outstanding warrants and for charges relating to the providing of a false name to a police officer, possession of narcotics paraphernalia, possession of concentrated cannabis, and resisting, obstructing and delaying an officer in the performance of his duties.
