EVENT: Located Missing Person At Risk

EVENT DATE: July 19, 2016

EVENT LOCATION: Crestmoor Canyon, San Bruno, California

On Tuesday, July 19, 2016, at approximately 12:50pm, San Bruno Police Officers learned that a missing person, identified as being at risk, may have been hiding in a heavily wooded area of Crestmoor Canyon in the City of San Bruno. The subject in question had been reported missing to the South San Francisco Police Department on Sunday, July 17, 2016. The reporting party feared that the missing subject may have been suicidal.

San Bruno Officers responded to the area of Crestmoor Canyon and initiated a search of the large, heavily wooded area. Officers were initially able to locate items belonging to the missing person, but were unable to locate the subject, himself. A San Bruno Police Canine was deployed to assist with the search. Following an extensive search, the canine "alerted" to the subject who has been concealed in very heavy brush. The subject was initially unresponsive, but eventually awoke and responded to Officers' directions to make his way out of the foliage.

The subject's face was swollen and he had suffered several cuts and bruises. He informed Officers that he had attempted suicide by taking approximately 250 sleeping pills and consuming alcohol. The subject last remembered being conscious on July 17, 2016. The subject was subsequently transported to a local hospital for treatment for both his physical and mental health condition.
