**SUBJECT:** Residential Burglary

On Tuesday, August 9, 2016, at approximately 12:31 p.m., San Bruno Police Officers responded to the 100 block of Siskiyou Court regarding the report of a residential burglary.

Arriving officers learned that the suspect gained entry to the residence through an unlocked sliding glass door located at the rear of the house. During the burglary, the suspect encountered a resident inside the home. The suspect punched the victim in an effort to escape and fled through the same rear door he had entered. Electronics were taken from the residence.

The suspect is depicted in an attached sketch and is described as being a Hispanic male, 5'11" to 6'00" tall with a heavy build and wearing a black shirt.
