On Wednesday, September 21, 2016, at 1:13 p.m. San Bruno Police Officers responded to the JCPenney Department Store at Tanforan Mall regarding the report of a robbery that had just occurred.

An ensuing investigation revealed that twenty-two year old Shaquett Thompson, a San Francisco resident, had shoplifted numerous items from the JCPenney Store. While fleeing the scene Thompson knocked a JC Penney employee to the ground. As Thompson continued to flee in a vehicle, she swerved toward the employee, running over both of the victim's arms and striking multiple parked vehicles. Thompson ultimately crashed her vehicle into a steel girder causing it to become disabled. Thompson then fled on foot. She was located by San Bruno Officers shortly thereafter and taken into custody.

The JC Penney employee was transported to a local hospital for treatment for injuries that were major, but not considered life threatening.

Thompson was booked into the San Mateo County Jail for charges related to attempted murder, robbery, and hit and run.
